Eligibility Rules & Information for  
***Knights of Columbus Scholarship Application***

1. To be eligible for a Knights of Columbus Scholarship, a candidate must meet one of the following criteria:
  - a) Must be a member in good standing;
  - b) Must be the son or daughter of a member in good standing.
  - c) Must be a son or daughter of a deceased member who was in good standing at the time of his death.
  - d) A letter from your father's Council must accompany your application verifying his status as a member in good standing.
  
2. To be eligible for a Knights of Columbus Scholarship, a candidate must meet all of the following criteria:
  - a) Must be entering their Freshman year in an approved college or university.
  - b) Must be a full time student.
  - c) Must be in a course of study leading towards a Bachelor Degree.
  
3. To be eligible for a Knights of Columbus Scholarship, all of the following items of information must be submitted to the scholarship board by April 15th:
  - a) Scholarship Application completed and signed by the applicant.
  - b) School report completed and signed by an official of the school.
  - c) Transcript of High School grades. (Must be include the first semester of the senior year)
  - d) College entrance test scores. (SAT or ACT)
  - e) Autobiographical statement to include the following topics:
    1. Church Activities.
    2. School Activities
    3. Community Activities
    4. Financial Needs
