Re: Delegate Voting at the State Convention

Greetings Brothers All,

In October your State Advocate along with myself were notified of an issue with our State By-Laws. Specifically, we were informed that Article 1 Section 2(a)(7) should be removed as it is inconsistent with Section 12(e) of the Order's Constitution. As a result, the section regarding the "1 Delegate, 2 Vote" issue has been removed.

I have since had discussions with the Supreme Advocate's office to ensure that things are done properly. In summary, each Council in good standing is entitled to send two delegates to the State Convention and each delegate shall have one vote. If a council is only represented by one delegate at the convention, the delegate will not be able to cast two votes. I appreciate your consideration on this matter and look forward to seeing many of you at the Convention in Clarksburg on May 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>.
